#### SECTION VII - SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

• Precautions to be taken in handling: wear gloves to protect against cuts from various sorts of papers whose sheets pass at high speeds.

#### SECTION IX - TRANSPORT

In order to avoid any physical, odorous, chemical or bacteriological contamination, all transport must be carried out while ensuring:

- In good condition of the means of transport (trailer, container): waterproof tarpaulin, dry floor, no roughness (absence of screws, protruding bolts, nails, wood debris or other)
- The cleanliness of the means of transport: absence of humidity, dust, oil or other liquids, absence of any particular odor.
- Not to carry out groupings with products not manufactured by Gascogne Papier

# **SECTION X - HANDLING**

# Storage room:

- Temperature between 0 and 30 ° C
- Hygrometry: between 30 and 70% RH
- Good general condition of the premises
- Building tightness: no water leaks, dust, pests (birds, rodents, insects)
- Cleanliness of the premises and in particular of the floors: no dust, cobwebs, liquids, debris, odors
- Do not mix in the same storage area the coils with other odorous materials to avoid cross contamination







## SECTION XI - ABOUT THE PRODUCT

- Keep items in their original packaging until use
- In the event of partial use, ensure that the product is repackaged after use
- Provide for stock rotation in order to avoid, if possible, a storage period of more than 1 year
- Prefer the storage of "standing" reels (on the edge)
- Ensure the tightness of the packaging
- In the event of significant differences in temperature or humidity (for example, between storage and workshop), moisture recovery cords may form on the top of the reels, they should then be removed before using the paper.
- Keep the identification label (s) until complete use of the items
